Subject: **Counselling for Admissions to BUMS Programme of Faculty of Medicine (Unani)**

Applicants for Admission to BUMS programme of faculty of Medicine (Unani) having NEET/AIPMT-2016 marks of 300 or more are required to appear in the Counselling session on **5<sup>th</sup> October 2016** at **Office of Dean, Faculty of Medicine (U)** between **10:00 am to 1:00 pm** along with the following documents.

**Documents required:**

1. Jamia Hamdard Online Application form printout
2. High School/Matric (10th) Certificate
3. Marks Sheets/Certificate of Class 12<sup>th</sup>
4. Character Certificate from the institution last attended
5. Migration/Transfer Certificate
6. Two Passport size recent colour photograph
7. Required amount of Annual Fee in Cash or Demand Draft.

Total Demand Draft required for General Category (66,000+8,000) = 74,000/- This includes the Library Fee of Rs. 5000/- (Refundable), Admission Fee of Rs.2000/- (one time) and Rs. 1000/- as Enrolment Fee (one time).

If the candidate is selected under SFS Category then the fee required will be Rs. 156,000+8,000 = Rs. 164,000/-

Demand Draft should be in favour of **Jamia Hamdard** payable at New Delhi.

For Urdu Qualification only High School (Class 10th) will be considered valid while any other Certificates like Adeeb Kamil, Munshi, Maulvi or Diploma will be treated as **not-eligible**.

Selection List will be declared at 3:00 pm. Same day on the basis of merit and availability of seats. Appearing in the Counselling session is not guarantee of admission.

Please note that the admission to the selected candidates will be given provisionally and final admission will be subject to the full verification of documents for eligibility as per CCIM norms and after getting approval of CCIM for admission to BUMS programme for the session 2016-17.

Date of subsequent round of counseling will be announced later, subject to availability of seats.
