All the candidates who have applied for admission to MD Unani Programme of Jamia Hamdard and appeared in ALL INDIA AYUSH POST GRADUATE ENTRANCE TEST (AIAPGET) 2017 are required to appear in the Counseling Session – I on **20.09.2017** between 09:30 am to 1:00 pm in the office of Dean, School of Unani Medicine, Jamia Hamdard, New Delhi – 110062. Candidates willing to participate in Counselling session should also have:

1. Passed BUMS Examination, securing at least 50% marks in the aggregate from Jamia Hamdard or from any other University recognized by Jamia Hamdard.
2. Completed the compulsory internship

Documents required:

1. Jamia Hamdard Online Application form printout
2. AIAPGET-2017 score card with admit card
2. High School/Matric (10th) Certificate
3. Marks Sheets/Certificate of BUMS
4. Internship certificate
5. Character Certificate from the institution last attended
6. Migration/Transfer Certificate
7. Two Passport size recent colour photographs
8. Required amount of Annual Fee in Cash or Demand Draft.

Demand Draft of Rs 93,000/- (83,000 annual fee + Rs 3000/- Admission Fee (one time) + Rs 2000/- Enrolment Fee (one time) and Rs 5000/- as Library security (refundable) in favor of "Jamia Hamdard" payable at New Delhi.

Note:

If any eligible candidate fails to appear in counseling on above mentioned date and time may forfeit the claim for admission or appearing in counseling in next cycle (if conducted).

Selection List will be declared at 3:30 pm. same day on the basis of merit and availability of seats. **Appearing in the Counselling session is not guarantee of admission.**

Please note that the admission to the selected candidates will be given provisionally and final admission will be offered after getting approval of CCIM for admission to BUMS programme for the session 2017-18.
