Final results of the Civil Services Examination

UPSC has announced the final results of the Civil Services Examination. Total 761 candidates have been recommended for appointment and maintained 150 candidates in reserved list. Out of which 180 for IAS, 200 IPS, 36 IFS, 302 Central Group "A" services and 118 Central Group "B" services.
