Burhan Majid is an Assistant Professor of Law at Hamdard Institute of Legal Studies and Research, School of Law, Jamia Hamdard. He's also a doctoral fellow at National Academy of Legal Studies and Research (NALSAR) University of Law, Hyderabad. His research focuses on the intersections of affirmative action and religious minorities in India and the constitutional trajectory of Jammu & Kashmir within the Indian Union. His teaching interests include Legal and Constitutional Theory, Comparative Constitutional Law, Constitutional Interpretation and Fundamental Rights.

He is also a recipient of prestigious research fellowships at the universities in the UK and Germany. In 2022, he was awarded the Indian Equality Law Fellowship by the Bonavero Institute of Human Rights, Faculty of Law, University of Oxford, United Kingdom. He has also been awarded the VRU-WCL Short-Term Fellowship by the Chair for Public and Comparative Law, Humboldt University, Berlin, Germany for Fall 2023. He has previously taught at Central University of Kashmir. Prior to joining teaching, he has worked as a lawyer at the High Court of Srinagar for close to a year dealing with service matters and preventive detention cases.
