Applications are invited from the eligible candidates for the post of **Assistant Professor in Economics and Sociology in Hamdard Institute of Legal Studies and Research (HILSR), School of Law** on substantive basis. The last date for the submission of applications is 14th September, 2020.

Details of Pay, Qualifications and other Requirements

Assistant Professor (Pay Matrix Academic Level - 10 of 7th CPC)

Eligibility (A or B):

- A. i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

(ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- a) The Ph.D degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D, work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conference/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

OR

- B.** The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign University/Institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix I shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

The applications for the position(s) may reach the office of the Assistant Registrar (Recruitment), Office of the Registrar, Jamia Hamdard, Hamdard Nagar, New Delhi - 110 062 on or before 14th September, 2020. The application must accompany a fee of Rs. 1,000 (Rupees one thousand only). The application without the valid fee will not be entertained.
