Nasser Munjee (DoB, November 18, 1952) was educated at the Leys School in Cambridge, UK and then went on to do his Bachelor and Masters degrees at the London School of Economics, UK. He spent a short while at the University of Chicago USA, before returning to India in 1977. His entire career has traversed the creation of financial institutions in India with a consistently abiding interest in the problems of development in an emerging economy. He embarked onto an illustrious career with the creation of the first mortgage company in India - the Housing Development Finance Corporation (HDFC) - with which he was associated for twenty years, rising to become its Executive Director. During this period HDFC grew from being a fledgling housing finance institution in India to a major financial network of institutions in the Indian financial system. Subsequently, Nasser Munjee, created the Infrastructure Development Finance Company (IDFC) in joint partnership with government and both domestic and international institutions with a singular mission “to lead private capital to commercially viable infrastructure finance in India” and not being merely a lender for projects. This hugely successful “Public Private Partnership” endeavor is considered revolutionary as it had both a project finance role as well as a lead policy maker role which changed the entire approach to infrastructure investment in the country. IDFC also created an equity fund to invest in new projects - the India Development Fund-which has also proved to be very successful. Since 2004, Nasser has been pursuing his own interests in his own way. He sits on 10 Corporate Boards in India which include Tata Motors, Tata Chemicals, Britannia Industries, Cummins India, ABB India, Ambuja Cements (now part of the HOLCIM group). He is also Chairman of DCB Bank, Tata Motors Finance and of the Aga Khan institutions namely Aga Khan Foundation (India) and Aga Khan Rural Support Programme (India). He is entrusted with the chairmanship of other institutes like Muniwarabad Charitable Trust, Global Infrasy Limited. His other associations include the Board of the South Asian Centre, London School of Economics, Indian Institute for Human Settlements, Charles Correa Urban Foundation, Goa, Board of the Schulich School of Management, University of Toronto, He is privileged to be on board of International companies like Jaguar Land Rover Plc, UK, Tata Chemicals North America, TATA Chemicals European Holdings, and is on the Advisory Board of the City of London, E&Y Tapestry Network. He is also the member of the European Audit Committee Network and Executive Committee of the World Islamic Economic Forum He was also the President of the Bombay Chamber of Commerce and Industry – the city's oldest Chamber of Commerce and he has served on numerous Government Task Forces on housing, Infrastructure and Urban Development.
