

“Hakeem Abdul Hameed Chair in School of Unani Medicine, Jamia Hamdard”

1. Background

Jamia Hamdard has established a Chair in the School of Unani Medicine in the name of Late Hakeem Abdul Hameed, a pioneer of Unani medicine who fostered advancement in the field of natural medicine through scientific research and also founded the Jamia Hamdard, an institution declared as # 1 in the country in the area of Pharmaceutical Sciences by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India based on NIRF 2017 ranking. The Chair will be occupied by exceptionally distinguished researcher/academician who is an internationally recognized leader in the field of Unani medicine, and will provide academic leadership to the School, primarily through demonstrating and fostering excellence in research, teaching and policy development related to Unani medicine at a variety of levels. In addition, the HAH Chair Professor would be expected to mentor young faculty and students so as to enhance the academic standards and achievements of Jamia Hamdard.

2. Eligibility

- i) Any citizen of India, Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) and Person of Indian Origin (PIO) working in India.
- ii) Minimum 10 years' experience as Professor of Unani medicine with significant and substantive contributions to teaching/research/practice in the domain of Unani medicine.
- iii) Retired or serving Professor of Unani medicine.
- iv) At least 3 books published in the area of Unani medicine.
- v) Age should not exceed 70 years, as on the date of nomination.

3. Tenure of Chair

The tenure of the Hakeem Abdul Hameed Chair will be three years.

4. Incentives

The Hakeem Abdul Hameed Chair shall receive remuneration equivalent to the highest emoluments drawn by a Professor at Jamia Hamdard. Other entitlements for research, travel etc. shall be as per University rules, as equivalent to those for a Professor.

5. Nomination Process

The application is only by nominations. Nominations should be addressed to the Vice Chancellor, Jamia Hamdard, Hamdard Nagar, New Delhi 110062 and sent along with a detailed Bio-Data including a statement of work, achievements, accomplishment or performance on which the claim to the Award is based (original + ten copies) latest by October 31, 2017. A CD/DVD/USB flash drive is also required containing digital photograph (in JPEG format), and the above mentioned documents (in PDF format) of the nominee. The envelope should be superscribed with 'Nomination for Hakeem Abdul Hameed Chair'.

6. Who can Nominate

i) The nominations as mentioned above can be sent by anyone of the following.

1. Principals of Unani Medical Colleges
2. Director Generals (Retired/Serving) of Council of Unani Medicine
3. Vice Chancellors (Retired/Serving) of any University
4. Directors of State Unani Directorate
5. Chairman, Unani Pharmacopeia Commission
6. Drug Controller General of India
7. Secretary, AYUSH
8. Directors of National Institute of Unani Medicine, Bangalore.

ii) The nominator must obtain written consent of the nominee and enclose the same with the nomination.

7. Procedure of Selection

i) The Hakeem Abdul Hameed Chair will be appointed on the recommendations of a high level Search-cum-Selection Committee which will consider nominations received as mentioned above, in addition to names of other suitable persons within their own knowledge.

ii) In all matters of Award, the decision of Jamia Hamdard shall be final.
