

Top Rank to Jamia Hamdard in the first ever National Ranking of Higher Education Institutes

It is a moment of great pride and happiness that Jamia Hamdard has got top ranks in Pharmacy and University category in the first ever national ranking of Indian Higher Education Institute conducted by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India under National Institute Ranking Framework (NIRF) [<https://www.nirfindia.org/Home>]. Jamia Hamdard ranked 3rd in Pharmacy among 454 Pharmacy institutes. The rankings were released by the Hon'ble Minister of Human Resourced Development Smt. Zubin Irani in a function organized at the Vigyan Bhawan on April 4, 2016 [http://mhrd.gov.in/sites/upload_files/mhrd/files/Press-Release_NIRF.pdf]. Top 10 ranked Universities/Institutes in the categories of Universities, Pharmacy, Management and Engineering were handed over certificates of ranking by the Minister.

Jamia Hamdard also fared well in the University ranking, as it got a rank of 18 among 233 Universities registered for ranking. It is good ranking considering the fact that we are small and focussed University with little financial support from other sources. However, under the dynamic leadership of a renowned Scientist Dr. G.N. Qazi Jamia Hamdard has progressed leaps and bounds in last about 8 years, especially in research and healthcare education. He has introduced a research culture in the University with emphasis on quality of publications, Ph.D. theses and research proposals. Jamia Hamdard has a strong Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) which monitors and ensures quality of publications, quality of theses and quality of collaborations. Jamia Hamdard is one of the few Universities in India which established a Directorate of Research under the Office of Advisor (Research). It is also one of the few Universities in India which has an Intellectual Property (IP) Management Cell to facilitate patenting by the faculty and research scholars and has a Research and Publication Ethics Committee which handles cases of research misconduct. Researchers of Science and Pharmacy are required to publish research paper in the journals having impact factor 1 or above (only Thomson Reuters impact factor considered) in order to become eligible for submission of Ph.D. thesis. It is also one of the few universities in India which has on-campus active international and national industry-managed R&D and training centres such as SunPharma (formerly Ranbaxy) managed Clinical Pharmacy Unit, Hilleman Labs managed vaccine research centre and BD Biosciences managed BD-JH FACS Academy for training and research in flow cytometry. Besides, Dr. Qazi has also initiated programme of incentivization of quality research by honouring and providing cash incentive to scholars and faculty who publish papers in high impact factor journals and papers with high citations. Dr. Qazi has also instituted 10 research fellowships (two post-doctoral and eight doctoral) from internal resources with name Jamia Hamdard Silver Jubilee Fellowships. These Fellowships are offered on competitive basis to brilliant scholars who have no financial support.

With ranking comes more responsibility and we commit ourselves to perseverance of better ranking next time.
