

The History of Jamia Hamdard began with the establishment of a small Unani Clinic in the year 1906 by Hakeem Hafiz Abdul Majeed. Currently, Jamia Hamdard is engaged in imparting high-quality teaching and research in the disciplines of Pharmacy, Science, Medicine, Nursing, Management, Information Technology, Allied Health Sciences, Islamic Studies, etc. In recognition of its excellent academic achievements, Jamia Hamdard has been accredited with an 'A+' Grade by the NAAC. Jamia Hamdard is ranked 1st in the field of Pharmaceutical sciences in the country by the Govt. of India (NIRF-2025 ranking). Jamia Hamdard was placed at 2nd rank in ho values and 5th in i100 values as per the SCOPUS dataset of all the Institutes that were awarded the DST PURSE grant. The publications of Jamia Hamdard have received >16 citations/paper, perhaps the 2nd highest in India. The h-index of Jamia Hamdard is more than 100, and i100 is 100.
