1. This is a general Academic Calendar. Schools will prepare their Academic Calendar keeping in view outline of this Calendar and compliance of requirement of total minimum 180 teaching days as per the UGC norms. Wherever applicable statutory norms of the Regulatory Councils should be given consideration. No changes shall be allowed in the schedule of vacations. The Academic Calendar prepared by Schools should be notified after the approval of the Competent Authority.
2. Schools may include few days as preparatory break before the examination.
3. Normal teaching will continue during supplementary and internal examinations.
4. Schools may include one (01) or two (02) days to celebrate special 'day(s)' declared at national and international levels relevant to their discipline such as Pharmacy Day, Nursing Day etc. International Yoga Day, Constitution Day, National Science Day, World Environmental Day and other such days declared by the Government of India will be celebrated at the institution level.
5. Normal teaching will be conducted during the internal assessment.
6. School-wise celebration of cultural festival and sport weeks/days shall not be allowed.
7. Each School will organize 'Induction Programme - *Deeksharamb*' for newly admitted students.
