

Vice Chancellor's Message



It is a privilege and honour to state that Jamia Hamdard retained the top ranking in the Pharmacy category as per the National Institutional Ranking Framework 2025 released by the Ministry of Education, Government of India. This is the 7th time, Jamia Hamdard achieved the top ranking out of 10 times. As far as the University Ranking is concerned, Jamia Hamdard continues to be figured in the top 50 institutions in the country. Our Management School and the Medical School also figured in the top hundred institutions in the country.

This year, Jamia Hamdard was able to complete the admissions, 2025-26 much before the stipulated time period. The induction programme for all the Departments/Centres/ Schools were conducted in time. The semester examinations were conducted on time and the results were declared within two weeks.

During this period, the University campus remained vibrant, hosting numerous national and international conferences, as well as a variety of sports and cultural activities. The highlight of the year was the Founder's Day celebration. On this occasion, Dr. Karan Singh delivered the Hakeem Abdul Hameed Lecture on 14 September 2025.

Jamia Hamdard signed a Memorandum of Understanding in December 2025 with Gyanbharatam, a Flagship Programme of the Ministry of Culture, Government of India, to strengthen national efforts in the preservation, conservation, digitization, translation, and research of India's manuscript heritage. At present, Jamia Hamdard is designated as a Cluster Centre, entrusted with leading manuscript-related activities for its collections as well as coordinating and supervising upto 20 Cluster Partner Centres across the country.

As far as research is concerned, Jamia Hamdard has over 1,000 research scholars on its rolls. The University's overall scientometric profile reflects strong performance, with 11,110 publications and 292,331 citations. According to Scopus data as of 31 December 2025, the average citations per paper stand at 26.3. The University has an h-index of 184, along with significant i10 and i5 citation indices, indicating the sustained impact and quality of its research output.
