APPOINTMENT FOR THE POSITION OF VICE CHANCELLOR OF JAMIA HAMDARD, NEW DELHI

The Vice-Chancellor, being the academic as well as administrative head, is expected to be:

1. A person of Indian origin with the highest level of competence, integrity, morals, ethics, and strong commitment to the institution.
2. A distinguished academician, with a minimum of ten years' experience as Professor in a University or ten years' experience in a reputed research and/or academic administrative organisation with proof of having demonstrated academic leadership.
3. A candidate committed to the vision and mission of Jamia Hamdard, with emphasis on excellence in higher education, healthcare, pharmacy, and interdisciplinary research.
4. In addition to academic excellence, the candidate must demonstrate substantial experience in Internal Revenue Generation (IRG) activities, including but not limited to mobilizing research grants, fostering industry collaborations, initiating consultancy projects, establishing endowment funds, promoting continuing education programs, and developing sustainable financial models. Experience in entrepreneurship development, international collaborations, and public-private partnerships that contribute to institutional growth and financial sustainability will be considered highly desirable.
5. The candidate should not exceed 65 years of age as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Salary and Service Conditions:

1. The terms and conditions of the service will be those as set forth in the Statutes and Regulations of the UGC and Jamia Hamdard.

Procedure for Appointment:

1. Appointment will be made from a panel of names recommended by the Search-cum-Selection Committee constituted under the provisions of the UGC (Institutions Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2023.
2. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to interact with and make a presentation on their vision for the University to the Search-cum-Selection Committee.
3. Five copies of signed applications in the prescribed format along with their Curriculum Vitae and copy of certificates of education and experience should reach on or before the stipulated date and time to:- **Office of the Registrar, Jamia Hamdard, Hamdard Nagar, New Delhi – 110062** by post/by hand and also via email at chancellor@jamiahamdard.ac.in on or before the last date i.e. **15th April, 2026 upto 5.00 pm.**

4. Applicants are required to submit the application fee of an amount of Rs.2000/- (Rupees two thousand only).
