‘Committed to Excellence in Higher Education’

Jamia Hamdard (JH) was declared as a deemed-to-be University by the Govt. of India in 1989 on the recommendation of University Grants Commission (UGC) under the UGC Act 1956 in recognition of the services provided by erstwhile educational institutes established by the Hamdard National Foundation (HNF). These institutes, built over a period of time, included the Hamdard College of Pharmacy, Hamdard Tibbi College, Rifaidda College of Nursing, the Institute of History of Medicine & Medical Research, and Indian Institute of Islamic Studies. Jamia Hamdard was inaugurated by the then Prime Minister of India, Shri Rajiv Gandhi on August 1, 1989, who in his inspiring inaugural address applauded the efforts of Hakeem Abdul Hameed Saheb, the Founder, for setting up a number of institutions of learning which were finally merged to form a “Deemed to be University” namely Jamia Hamdard. In the words of Shri Rajiv Gandhi, “This will enable minority to go forward and help India to march forward”. Spread over a sprawling green campus of about 100 acres, located on a prime piece of land in South Delhi, JH has ten Schools including a medical college, two hospitals - a 550 bedded modern medicine hospital and another 150 bedded Unani medicine hospital - on its campus. It has a big library, archive centre, separate hostels for girls and boys, gymnasium, a large playground, residential quarters for the staff, and also an off-campus in Kannur, Kerala.

The University has been maintaining a steady progress in all facets in its existence of 31 years and is both nationally and internationally recognized for the quality of teaching and research. The overall progress in this period has been excellent in terms of infrastructure and maintaining the standards which is evident from the placement records, high quality of research, publications and patents. Jamia Hamdard is ranked 1st in the field of Pharmaceutical sciences in the country by the Govt. of India (NIRF-2024 ranking). Jamia Hamdard is a UGC, Ministry of Education maintained deemed- to-be University managed by a private trust, Hamdard National Foundation (HNF). The University has been a recipient of special grants such as the PURSE (Promotion for University Research in Science and Engineering) grant, and very recently got Rs. 10 Cr from AYUSH Ministry under the Centre for Excellence Scheme of the Ministry. It has recently received a generous funding under STUITI, a DST scheme DST’s PURSE (Promotion for University Research in Science and Engineering) Grant.

The Founder-Chancellor of Jamia Hamdard, Hakeem Abdul Hameed (1908-1999), was a renowned physician of the Unani system of medicine, and a noted philanthropist who dedicated his life to serving the neediest members of society. Admired by all and counting global dignitaries among his patients, Hakeem Sahab, as he was popularly known, kept public service as his driving force throughout his career.

He was conferred with Padma Shri in 1965 and Padma Bhushan in 1992 by the Government of India. He was awarded the prestigious Avicenna Award by the erstwhile USSR in 1983. In October 2000, the Research Centre for Islamic History, Art, and Culture in Istanbul, Turkey, presented the IRCICA Award to him posthumously for 'Patronage in Preservation of Cultural Heritage and promotion of Scholarship'. He won various other awards and distinctions in his lifetime. He also served as Chancellor of Aligarh Muslim University.

Over a period of time, Hakim Sahab set up a complex of educational institutions in Hamdard Nagar, Tughlakabad, which were finally amalgamated as Jamia Hamdard (Deemed to be University) in May 1989. The first institute to come up on the Tughlakabad land was the Institute of the History of Medicine and Medical Research (IHMMR). The foundation stone for this institute was laid on November 15, 1962, by the then Prime Minister of India, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru. The finished building was later inaugurated by the then Prime Minister, Mrs. Indira Gandhi. When a Deemed to be University status was granted in 1989, Jamia Hamdard was inaugurated by Mr. Rajiv Gandhi, the then Prime Minister.

Apart from Jamia Hamdard, Hakeem Sahab set up a number of other enduring institutions, including Hamdard National Foundation, Hamdard Education Society, Hamdard Study Circle, Business and Employment Bureau, Hamdard Public School, Ghalib Academy, Centre for South Asian Studies. He was also a founder patron of India Islamic Cultural Centre.

The Open Learning System allows a learner to determine his/her pace of learning and provides education at the doorstep of the learners. The mode of transaction is through self-learning material, counselling, and material through internet and various other media. The Centre for Distance and Online Education is offering various Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Diploma Programmes in Open and Distance Learning and Online mode.

All the Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes of Open and Distance Learning and Online programmes are being offered by the Centre for Distance and Online Education, Jamia Hamdard as per the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and with the approval of Distance Education Bureau, UGC.

The distance education also has potential to reach to the un-reached and even marginalized and excluded groups of the society such as tribal populations and Muslim women. Open and distance education provides an opportunity to students for acquiring new knowledge and skills that are needed for their development. Jamia Hamdard being in education for a long time has taken initiatives to offer an opportunity to those students who are unable to get on - campus education and those who have limited access to educational resources.

The flexible and innovative methods of education of Open and Distance Learning system ensures 'independent learning' to anyone, anytime and anywhere. The ODL and Online Programmes of Jamia Hamdard also envisages providing an opportunity to girls from Muslim community, who by and large has been left out by the national educational endeavours.

Jamia Hamdard's study programmes under ODL are selective and customized to meet the learning requirements of knowledge seekers as well as to ensure that they learn at their own pace and convenience. Within the financial means of University, due care has been taken to keep the cost of education low, so that educationally backward sections can take advantage of University's programmes through ODL mode. This goal in view, the CDOE of Jamia Hamdard has made concerted efforts to offer professional and job oriented courses with regular updates of curricula and study material and introduction of tools of Information Technology.

The Academic Programmes of CDOE in ODL and Online Mode

The Centre for Distance and Online Education, Jamia Hamdard offers education through ODL and Online mode in few selected programmes where University has tremendous strength. The courses are designed and developed with views to prepare a cadre of manpower with requisite knowledge and professional skills so that they can effectively function in the globalised economy, which is no doubt highly knowledge intensive. Guidelines for Admission and Examinations of ODL / Online Programmes

Admissions

All the admissions in ODL and Online Programmes are done through online portal of CDOE, Jamia Hamdard www.jamiahamdardonline.ac.in and www.jamiahamdardonline.in

Academic Counselling Sessions

The schedule for academic counselling sessions is published on the Center for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) website by the respective Program Coordinators. For students enrolled in Open and Distance Learning (ODL) programs, face-to-face counselling sessions are organized to provide direct academic support. Conversely, students of online programs participate in online classes for their counselling sessions. Learners are encouraged to remain in regular contact with their Programme Coordinator for up-to-date schedules, program-related information, and academic support. Contact details of Program Coordinators can be found on the CDOE website as well as in the programme prospectus.

Examinations

For ODL Programmes:

The CDOE, Jamia Hamdard conducts its examination for ODL programmes in its class rooms available in CDOE and library building as per the requirements. The proctored examination for online programmes are conducted through LMS.

- ⦿ All the students of ODL Programme will be required to appear in the end semester examination at Jamia Hamdard examination centre only.
- ⦿ Examination schedule will be notified by the Centre for Distance and Online Education, Jamia Hamdard and will be communicated to the students through our website.
- ⦿ The prescribed Examination Fee of Rs.2000.00 per semester shall have to be deposited along with the semester fee.
- ⦿ The medium of examination shall be English.
- ⦿ Students will be required to fill in Examination Form at least two months before the commencement of the examination. Late submission of examination form will be allowed only with the payment of late fine declared by the CDOE, after the notified date. In any case no examination form will be accepted after this deadline.
- ⦿ Admit Card of the examination may be collected from the CDOE, 10 days before commencement of the examination.
- ⦿ Candidates who fail in one or more paper (s) will have to re-appear in the next examination to clear backlog papers by paying the backlog fee of Rs.500/- per paper.
- ⦿ Results will be declared and displayed on the CDOE, Jamia Hamdard website.
- ⦿ A student shall have to attain minimum passing percentage of 40% in individual paper.

For Online Programmes

The proctored examination of Online programmes are conducted through the LMS on Qurio portal. However, there is flexibility of appearing in Online Examinations according to the convenience of the student. The exam portal remain open from 8.30 a.m. to 8.30 p.m. and the student may appear in examination for three hours as per guidelines of CDOE.

Candidates who fail in one or more paper (s) will have to re-appear in the next examination to clear backlog papers by paying the backlog fee of Rs.500/- per paper.

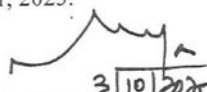
Subject: Guidelines regarding Learner mobility from ODL to Online and vice-versa in ODL and Online programmes being offered by the Centre for Distance and Online Education, Jamia Hamdard from July-August, 2025 session.

The existing UGC-DEB and AICTE Regulations permit learners mobility from ODL to Online and vice-versa in the same Institution with the approval of the Statutory Body of the concerned HEIs. In view of the several requested being received from the students of CDOE, the following modalities have been approved by the Vice-Chancellor in exercise of his powers under Regulation 23 C (3) of UGC (Institutions Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2023 for change of mode of study of CDOE learners from July-August, 2025 session:

1. A request from a learner of CDOE for change of mode of study viz Online to ODL or ODL to Online mode shall be considered by the Director, CDOE when such a request in writing is received within a period of 30 days from the closing date of admission in academic cycle (January/July).
2. Once such request for change of mode of learning is accepted and informed to the learner concerned, no withdrawal shall be permissible and the learner has to continue his/her study in that mode only.
3. The same enrolment (ODL/Online) shall continue even after the change of mode accepted by the CDOE.
4. There shall be no additional fee charged for the above purpose.
5. Change of ODL mode to Online mode cases beyond the one-month period in the first semester shall be considered from time to time with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor, Jamia Hamdard with a special fee of Rs.1500/-.

The above guidelines will be applicable for the learners of BBA and BCA (ODL/OL) programmes being offered by the CDOE, Jamia Hamdard admitted in July-August, 2025 academic session and onwards or any new courses under OL and ODL programmes to be introduced by CDOE. The matter shall be reported to BoS and Academic Council for ratification.

Pursuing two Academic Programmes simultaneously – Guidelines by UGC-DEB

The Online and ODL programmes offered under the Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE), Jamia Hamdard are governed by UGC (ODL & ONLINE) Regulations, 2020 and other guidelines issued by the UGC from time to time. According to UGC guidelines for pursuing two Academic Programmes simultaneously issued vide D.O. No.1-6/2007 (CPP-II) (New) dated 13.4.2022 and modified vide UGC letter D.O. No.F.1-6/2007 (CPP-II) (Comp.No.108737) dated 5.6.2025: https://www.ugc.gov.in/pdfnews/5729348_Guidelines-for-pursuing-two-academic-programmes-simultaneously.pdf

“A student can pursue two academic programmes, one in full time physical mode and another in Open and Distance Learning (ODL)/Online mode; or up to two ODL/Online programmes simultaneously”.



Self-Learning Material (SLM)

The Self-Learning Material (SLM) at Jamia Hamdard is meticulously developed by the internal faculty in collaboration with subject matter experts from various universities and institutions across the country. The material undergoes a thorough review process involving both internal and external experts to ensure its academic rigor. Following this review, it is carefully edited, updated, and modified as needed before being printed and distributed to students. In line with evolving knowledge and advancements, the syllabus is regularly updated to maintain the highest standards of quality in course content. For online programs, students are provided with soft copies of the SLM to support their learning.

Delivery of Self-Learning Material

The Self-Learning Material (SLM) is delivered to learners enrolled in Online programs. For ODL students, the SLM is distributed in printed form directly from the Center for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) office at Jamia Hamdard. In contrast, students enrolled in online programs receive their SLM in digital format via the Learning Management System (LMS). This ensures easy access to learning resources tailored to each mode of study.

Library Facility

Students enrolled in ODL / Online programmes may use the HMS Central Library of Jamia Hamdard (Gol Building). They will be allowed to use this facility on production of their Identity Card issued by the Centre for Distance and Online Education, Jamia Hamdard. However, they will not be issued any book against their name.

Evaluation Criteria

The examination process for both ODL and online programs consists of two components: Internal Assessment, with a weightage of 30%, and the End Semester Examination, carrying 70%. To successfully pass, students must secure at least 40% in each component.

Re-evaluation

A student can apply for re-evaluation of the failed papers. The fee for re-evaluations is Rs.1000/- per paper. However, no request for re-evaluation will be entertained after fifteen days of declaration of results/receipt of mark sheet.

Provisional / Migration / Degree Certificate

Upon successful course completion, the degree issuance fee is ₹1500.00, and the fee for obtaining a provisional certificate is ₹500.00.

A Migration Certificate can be issued to enrolled students upon request. Upon successful completion of the program, a Migration Certificate will be issued to students who submit a written request along with proof of payment of the prescribed fee of ₹500.00 to Jamia Hamdard.

Please note that this information may be subject to change. Jamia Hamdard reserves the right to modify its admission and examination policies. Official notifications will be posted on the CDOE, Jamia Hamdard website as needed.

It is notified that the students of Jamia Hamdard / CDOE who have completed Undergraduate, Postgraduate or Diploma programmes from Jamia Hamdard desirous of getting their names /date of birth /parent's name changed in the University records based on the change carried out by the CBSE/ State Boards/Such other Boards in their records in Class X and Class XII will be required to submit the following documents to facilitate change of their name in the University records:

- A copy of Gazette of India Notification (*about the name change*)
- Copies of Two Indian National Newspapers (*"*)
- Self-declaration in the form of an Affidavit in the Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs.100/- duly attested by a First Class Magistrate
- Marksheet / Certificate of Class 10th and 12th issued by CBSE /State Boards/other related Boards.
- Photo Identify Proof issued by the Government i.e. Aadhar Card, PAN Card, Voter ID Card, Passport, Driving License (Any one).

It is the sole responsibility of the student/former student to ensure that the documents submitted by him/her are authentic/genuine.

Following fee is required to be submitted for one request encompassing one or more matters:

- Fee for change of name / name of parent(s) / date of birth of a current student shall be Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only).
- Fee for change of name/name of parent(s) / date of birth of a former student who has passed out less than 10 years ago from the date of the request – Rs.5000/- (Rupees five thousand only).
- Fee for change of name / name of parent(s) / date of birth of a former student who has passed out more than 10 years ago from the date of the request – Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only).

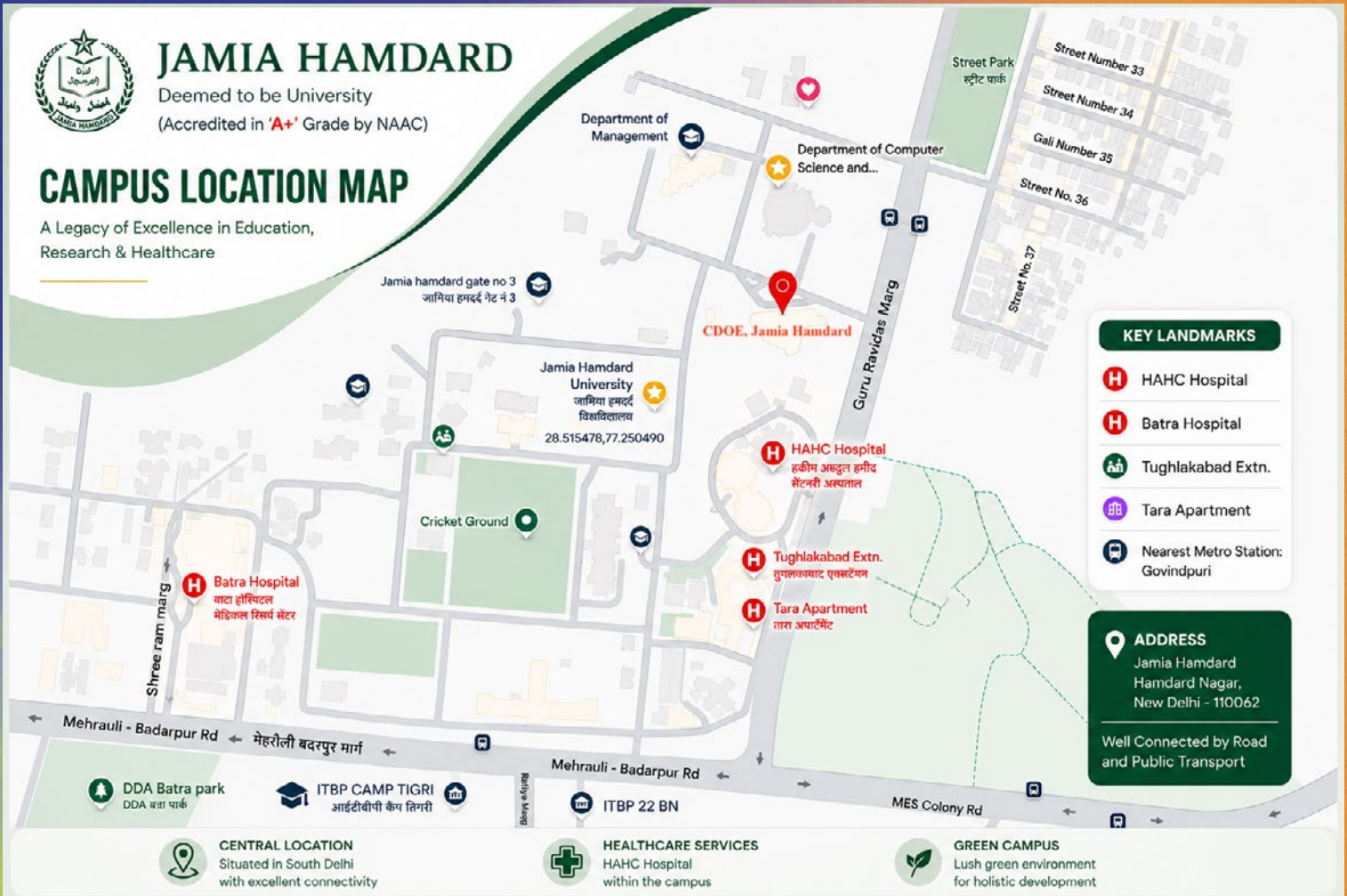
