- Word limit for the abstract is 250 words.
- The acceptance for oral/poster presentations will be sent through mail.
- **Poster dimension should be 4 feet in height and 3 feet in width.**
- **Oral presenters should have up to maximum of 15 slides and will be given 5+2 min for presentation followed by discussion.**

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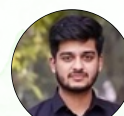
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SIGHTSEEING IN & AROUND DELHI

BY FLIGHT:

New Delhi is well connected to all major cities in India and abroad via regular flights.

BY TRAIN:

You can easily get regular trains from all major cities of the country. Delhi has more than 20 Railway Stations. The selected major stations within Delhi are: Anand Vihar Terminal (ANVT), New Delhi (NDLS), Delhi Hazrat Nizamuddin (NZM), Delhi Sarai Rohilla (DEE) and Delhi Cantt (DEC).

JAMIA HAMDARD (CONVENTION CENTRE):

Jamia Hamdard is situated in the heart of the city at Mehrauli-Badarpur Road in Hamdard Nagar, Tughlakabad Institutional Area near Batra Hospital, in the vicinity of Khanpur, Sangam Vihar, Tughlaq Fort, Tara Apartment and Alaknanda market.

LOCAL TRANSPORT

New Delhi is well-connected through an efficient network of public and private transport options:

- **Metro:** The nearest metro stations to the venue are Govind Puri (Violet Line from Kashmiri Gate), Greater Kailash (Magenta Line) and Saket (Yellow Line from New Delhi Railway Station), both located within 2–3 km of the campus.
- **App-based Cabs:** Services like Uber, Ola, and Rapido are widely available for convenient point-to-point travel.
