

Two-Day Workshop on Midwifery Skill Training

The Department of Obstetrical and Gynecological Nursing, Rufaida College of Nursing, School of Nursing Education & Research, Jamia Hamdard, successfully organized the second batch of two-day Midwifery Skill Training workshop on 9th and 10th April, 2026, at the Midwifery Skills Lab, Jamia Hamdard. The workshop was coordinated by Ms. Somibala Thokchom, Organizing Secretary and Assistant Professor, and Ms. Mikki, Assistant Professor and Co-organizing secretary, under the chairpersonship of Prof. Veena Sharma, Dean and Principal, RCN, SNER, Jamia Hamdard. The programme aimed to strengthen the clinical competencies of nursing professionals through structured, hands-on training, skill demonstrations, and evidence-based midwifery practices. The sessions included demonstrations on essential midwifery skills, simulation-based learning, case discussions, and supervised practice, enabling participants to enhance their confidence and clinical decision-making abilities. A total of 21 nursing professionals from five institutions in Delhi benefited from this comprehensive training programme and were awarded 12 Delhi Nursing Council (DNC) credit points. The programme concluded with a post-test and feedback session, during which participants expressed high satisfaction with the organization, the relevance of the content, and the workshop's practical orientation, appreciating its contribution to improving the quality of maternal care and enhancing professional skills.
