As recommended by the 173rd SC of AC duly approved by the 49th Academic Council in its meetings held on 21.07.2025 & 21.08.2025 respectively, **the University Academic Calendar for the Year 2025-2026** is hereby notified as under:

Foundation Day	May 10, 2026

University Re-opens for the new session	July 06, 2026
Commencement of Classes of on-going batches	July 06, 2026

1. This is general Academic Calendar. Schools will prepare their Academic Calendar keeping in view outline of this Calendar and compliance of requirement of total minimum 180 teaching days as per the UGC norms. Wherever applicable, the statutory norms of the Regulatory Councils should be given consideration. No changes shall be allowed in the schedule of vacations. The Academic Calendar prepared by Schools should be notified after the approval of the Competent Authority.
2. Schools may include few days as preparatory break before the examination.
3. Normal teaching will continue during supplementary and internal examinations.
4. Schools may include one (01) or two (02) days to celebrate special 'day(s)' declared at national and international levels relevant to their discipline such as Pharmacy Day, Nursing Day, World Environmental Day etc. Other such important days like the International Yoga Day, International Women's Day, Constitution Day, National Science Day, National Voters Day, Independence and Republic Day and other such days declared by the Government of India will be celebrated at the university level.
5. School-wise celebration of cultural festival and sport weeks/days shall not be allowed.
6. Each School will organize 'Induction Programme - Deeksharamb' for newly admitted students.

The Academic Council also ratified the action of the Vice-Chancellor in respect of approving Academic Calendar 2025-26 for JH Kannur Campus, Kerala.
